4. Summer Steps Internship Program

Kaitlyn Miller made a presentation regarding the City's Summer Steps internship program, including outcomes and participation rates. The program generated 454 applications and 22 students were accepted into the program, including 11 from WUSD. The presentation also included plans to increase participation and streamline the program for next year.

5. Youth Fire Academy

Kaitlyn Miller and Chief John Heilmann made a presentation regarding the WSFD's upcoming Youth Fire Academy, including outreach and application rates. The program generated 14 applications, all of which were accepted into the program, with 12 applicants from WUSD. The presentation also included plans to increase outreach and participation for the program's next session in summer 2016.

6. Career Tech - Update

Superintendent Luna provided an update on the Career Tech program, including the issuance of a three-year grant from the California Department of Education. The grant will fund implementation and expansion of CTE curriculum in the WUSD.

7. Other Business

Mayor Cabaldon discussed the collaboration of FutureReady with Juma to place students in CTE Pathways into food service jobs at the new Sacramento Arena. Members also discussed opportunities for partnerships between the City and WUSD, including the City applying to be one of the first "Cities of LRNG" and the benefit LRNG's digital badging program could provide to WUSD students. Member Sandeen requested a status update on the LRNG program at the next meeting.
